Vigyan Mela, the Science exposition aimed at the development of the scientific temper and mathematic fervour in the minds of young learners. It enhanced experiential learning where the students proficiently presented the ideas of the concepts through models, experiments, power point presentations and Maths exhibits.

We conducted a variety of competitions including Quiz on different dates. Students were categorised into four levels - Sishu for classes 4 and 5, Bala for classes 6 to 8, Kishore for 9 and 10 and Tarun for classes 11 and 12.

Students prepared the models based on Electro Magnetic Induction, Sensors, Biotechnology, Electrochemistry, Waste management, Cleanliness of Environment Natural Disasters, First Aid, Food Preservation etc., according to their interests and skills.

Smt. Dr. Chinnammal Janaki, Assistant Professor in Physics, DGD Vaishnav Collage Arumbakkam, Chennai inaugurated the exposition on 12 August 2023. She motivated the students to utilise the opportunities provided to them to explore and experience Science by getting involved in. She visited the display and gave valuable feedback. Around 240 students from classes 4 to 12 participated in the Vigyan Mela.

The 1st prize winners of all the events will participate in the VES School level competitions to be held at Vyasarpadi on 24 and 26 of August. Then, the winners of VES level will be participating in Vibag / Kshetra level competitions.
